

This market will resolve to "No" if any of the following conditions are met between market creation and December 31, 2026, 11:59 ET:

- Trump out as President
- China invades Taiwan
- Xi Jinping out
- U.S. invades Iran
- Iranian regime falls
- Bitcoin hits '↑ 1M' or '↓ 10k'
- Jeffrey Epstein alive
- Republican Trifecta with Supermajority in the Senate
- Russia invades a NATO country
- Trump acquires Greenland
- 9.0 or above earthquake
- Major volcano eruption (VEI ≥6)
- Major meteor strike (250kt+)

Otherwise, this market will resolve to "Yes".

1. Trump out as President

This market will resolve to "No" if Donald Trump resigns or is removed as President or otherwise ceases to be the President of the United States for any period of time during this market's above-specified time frame.

An announcement of Donald Trump's resignation/removal before this market's end date will immediately resolve this market to "No", regardless of when the announced resignation/removal goes into effect.

Only permanent removal from office will qualify. Temporary removal (e.g., temporary invocation of the 25th Amendment under Section 3 or a Section 4 invocation not sustained by both Houses of Congress) or impeachment without removal will not count.

A sustained invocation of the Twenty-Fifth Amendment, Section 4 (i.e., if both Houses of Congress, by two-thirds vote, uphold the Vice President and Cabinet's determination of presidential inability) will qualify for a "No" resolution.

The resolution source for this market will be a consensus of credible reporting.

2. China invades Taiwan

This market will resolve to "No" if China commences a military offensive intended to establish control over any portion of the Republic of China (Taiwan) during this market's above-specified time frame.

Territory under the administration of the Republic of China, including any inhabited islands, will qualify; however, uninhabited islands will not qualify.

The resolution source for this market will be official confirmation by China, Taiwan, the United Nations, or any permanent member of the UN Security Council; however, a consensus of credible reporting will also be used.

3. Xi Jinping out

This market will resolve to "No" if China's General Secretary of the Communist Party, Xi Jinping, is removed from power for any length of time during this market's above-specified time frame.

CCP General Secretary Xi Jinping will be considered removed from power if he announces his resignation from his role as General Secretary, or is otherwise dismissed, detained, disqualified, or

otherwise loses his position, or is prevented from fulfilling his duties as General Secretary within this market's timeframe.

The primary resolution source for this market will be a consensus of credible reporting.

4. U.S. invades Iran

This market will resolve to "No" if the United States commences a military offensive intended to establish control over any portion of Iranian land territory during this market's above-specified time frame.

For the purposes of this market, land de facto controlled by Iran or the United States, as of market creation, will be considered the sovereign territory of that country.

The resolution source for this market will be a consensus of credible reporting.

5. Iranian regime falls

This market will resolve to "No" if the Islamic Republic of Iran's current ruling regime is overthrown, collapsed, or otherwise ceases to govern during this market's above-specified time frame.

This requires a broad consensus of reporting indicating that core structures of the Islamic Republic (e.g. the office of the Supreme Leader, the Guardian Council, IRGC control under clerical authority) have been dissolved, incapacitated, or replaced by a fundamentally different governing system or otherwise lost de facto power over a majority of the population of Iran. This could occur via revolution, civil war, military coup, or voluntary abdication, but only qualifies if the Islamic Republic no longer exercises sovereign power.

Routine political events such as elections, reforms, or leadership succession do not qualify. Internal coups or power shifts that preserve the Islamic Republic's core structures also do not qualify. Only a clear break in continuity—such as a new provisional government, revolutionary council, or constitution replacing the Islamic Republic will qualify.

Partial loss of territory or challenges from rebel or exile groups will not qualify unless the Islamic Republic no longer administers the majority of the Iranian population within Iran.

The resolution source will be a consensus of credible reporting.

6. Bitcoin hits ↑ 1M

This market will immediately resolve to "No" if any Binance 1 minute candle for Bitcoin (BTC/USDT) during this market's above-specified time frame has a final "High" price equal to or greater than the price specified in the title.

The resolution source for this market is Binance, specifically the BTC/USDT "High" prices available at https://www.binance.com/en/trade/BTC_USDT, with the chart settings on "1m" for one-minute candles selected on the top bar.

Please note that the outcome of this market depends solely on the price data from the Binance BTC/USDT trading pair. Prices from other exchanges, different trading pairs, or spot markets will not be considered for the resolution of this market.

7. Bitcoin hits ↓ 10k

This market will immediately resolve to "No" if any Binance 1 minute candle for Bitcoin (BTC/USDT) during this market's above-specified time frame has a final "Low" price equal to or lower than the price specified in the title.

The resolution source for this market is Binance, specifically the BTC/USDT "Low" prices available at https://www.binance.com/en/trade/BTC_USDT, with the chart settings on "1m" for one-minute candles selected on the top bar.

Please note that the outcome of this market depends solely on the price data from the Binance BTC/USDT trading pair. Prices from other exchanges, different trading pairs, or spot markets will not be considered for the resolution of this market.

8. Jeffrey Epstein alive

This market will resolve to "No" if incontrovertible proof is publicly revealed that Jeff Epstein, the New York financier, is still alive during this market's above-specified time frame.

The primary resolution source for this market will be a consensus of credible sources.

9. Republican Trifecta with Supermajority in the Senate

This market will resolve to "No" if, during this market's above-specified time frame, the Republican Party controls the U.S. presidency, the U.S. House of Representatives, and at least 60 seats in the U.S. Senate.

A party will be considered to have 'control' of the House of Representatives if it wins a majority of voting seats.

If control of the House is ambiguous, given the above rules, this market will resolve according to the party affiliation of the first Speaker of the US House who is selected following the 2026 United States midterm elections.

A candidate's party is determined by their ballot-listed or otherwise identifiable affiliation with that party at the time the 2026 United States midterm elections are conclusively called by this market's resolution sources. A candidate without a ballot-listed affiliation to either the Democrat or Republican Parties will be considered a member of one of these parties based on the party that they most recently expressed their intent to caucus with at the time the 2026 United States midterm elections are conclusively called by this market's resolution sources.

The resolution source for this market is the Associated Press, Fox News, and NBC. If all three sources do not achieve consensus in calling the relevant races for this market, it will resolve based on the official certification.

10. Russia invades a NATO country

This market will resolve to "No" if Russia commences a military offensive intended to establish control over any portion of any NATO country during this market's above-specified time frame.

For the purposes of this market, land de facto controlled by NATO member states or Russia as of May 28, 2025, will be considered the sovereign territory of those countries.

Hybrid or "grey zone" operations conducted by unmarked personnel will qualify if they are confirmed to be Russian operatives and are intended to establish de facto control over territory, as occurred in Crimea (2014) or Donbas (2014–2022).

The resolution source for this market will be a consensus of credible sources.

11. Trump acquires Greenland

This market will resolve to "No" if the United States officially announces that Greenland will come under US sovereignty during this market's above-specified time frame.

Sovereignty is defined as the transfer of the majority of the territory of Greenland from its current status as an autonomous territory within the Kingdom of Denmark to being under the formal governance or jurisdiction of the United States, either as a state, territory, or other classification within the US system.

An official announcement made by the United States and Denmark that Greenland will come under US sovereignty will qualify, even if the actual transfer of sovereignty is yet to occur. Only announcements of official agreements or actions (e.g. executive order, signed legislation, etc.) will count - mere posts on Social Media will not.

The resolution source for this market will be official information from the governments of the US, Greenland, and Denmark, however a consensus of credible reporting confirming that Greenland has come under U.S. sovereignty will also qualify.

12. 9.0 or above earthquake

This market will resolve to "No" if one or more earthquakes with a magnitude of 9.0 or higher occur anywhere on Earth during this market's above-specified time frame.

The resolution source for this market is the United States Geological Survey (USGS) Earthquake Hazards Program (<https://earthquake.usgs.gov/earthquakes/browse/significant.php#sigdef>).

If an earthquake of substantial size has occurred within this market's timeframe but not yet appeared on the resolution source, this market may remain open until January 31, 2027, 11:59 PM ET, or until the earthquake in question otherwise appears on the resolution source. If such an earthquake has not appeared on the resolution source by that date, another credible resolution source will be used.

After a qualifying earthquake is registered, this market will remain open for 24 hours to account for any revisions to its recorded magnitude. After 24 hours, this market will resolve according to the latest provided data.

13. Major volcano eruption (VEI ≥ 6)

This market will resolve to "No" if a natural volcanic eruption is classified as having a Volcanic Explosivity Index (VEI) of 6 or higher at any point during this market's above-specified time frame.

The eruption must be classified as a natural volcanic event of any Eruption Type (i.e., Explosive, Effusive, Phreatic, Lava Lake, Submarine, or similar); eruptions caused by artificial activity, testing, or human-induced explosions do not qualify.

The primary resolution source will be the Smithsonian Institution Global Volcanism Program (GVP: <https://volcano.si.edu/>), specifically the Max VEI figures released on the "Eruptions in 2026 (New/Total)" page once released. The relevant field for determining eruption strength is the assigned VEI value for the eruptive event. If this dataset has not been updated to include all relevant events by February 28, 2027, or if the Smithsonian GVP becomes permanently unavailable, this market may resolve based on a consensus of credible scientific sources, including the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS), national or regional volcanic observatories, or credible reporting of a scientific consensus.

14. Major meteor strike (250kt+)

This market will resolve to "No" if a natural meteoroid (bolide) explodes in Earth's atmosphere with a total impact energy greater than or equal to 250 kilotons of TNT equivalent during this market's above-specified time frame.

The object must be classified as a natural meteoroid; events involving artificial objects or reentry vehicles do not qualify.

The primary resolution source will be the NASA JPL Fireball and Bolide Data repository: <https://cneos.jpl.nasa.gov/fireballs/>. The relevant field for determining impact energy is the “Impact Energy (kt)” column. If this dataset has not been updated to include all relevant dates by February 28, 2027, or if the NASA JPL Fireball and Bolide Data repository becomes permanently unavailable, this market may resolve based on a consensus of credible sources including the European Space Agency (ESA), the International Asteroid Warning Network (IAWN), the U.S. Department of Defense, or credible reporting of a scientific consensus, such as a NASA press release.
