

This market will resolve to "Something" if any of the following conditions are met between market creation and February 28, 2026, 11:59 PM ET:

- US strikes Iran
- Israel strikes Iran
- Gov Shutdown for 10+ days
- Russia x Ukraine ceasefire
- André Ventura wins Portugal Presidential Election
- LDP does not win most seats in Japan General Election
- Gold (GC) hits ↑ \$8,000
- Bitcoin hits ↓ 60,000
- Khamenei out as Supreme Leader of Iran
- Insurrection Act invoked

Otherwise, this market will resolve to "Nothing".

#### 1. US strikes Iran

This market will resolve to "Something" if the US initiates a drone, missile, or air strike on Iranian soil or any official Iranian embassy or consulate during this market's above-specified time frame.

For the purposes of this market, a qualifying "strike" is defined as the use of aerial bombs, drones or missiles (including cruise or ballistic missiles) launched by US military forces that impact Iranian ground territory or any official Iranian embassy or consulate (e.g., if a weapons depot on Iranian soil is hit by an US missile, this market will resolve to "Something").

Missiles or drones that are intercepted and surface-to-air missile strikes will not be sufficient for a "Something" resolution, regardless of whether they land on Iranian territory or cause damage.

Actions such as artillery fire, small arms fire, FPV or ATGM strikes directly, ground incursions, naval shelling, cyberattacks, or other operations conducted by US ground operatives will not qualify.

The resolution source will be a consensus of credible reporting.

#### 2. Israel strikes Iran

This market will resolve to "Something" if Israel initiates a drone, missile, or air strike on Iranian soil or any official Iranian embassy or consulate during this market's above-specified time frame.

For the purposes of this market, a qualifying "strike" is defined as the use of aerial bombs, drones or missiles (including cruise or ballistic missiles) launched by Israeli military forces that impact Iranian ground territory or any official Iranian embassy or consulate (e.g., if a weapons depot on Iranian soil is hit by an Israeli missile, this market will resolve to "Something").

Missiles or drones that are intercepted and surface-to-air missile strikes will not be sufficient for a "Something" resolution, regardless of whether they land on Iranian territory or cause damage.

Actions such as artillery fire, small arms fire, FPV or ATGM strikes directly, ground incursions, naval shelling, cyberattacks, or other operations conducted by Israeli ground operatives will not qualify.

The resolution source will be a consensus of credible reporting.

### 3. Gov Shutdown for 10+ days

This market will resolve to "Something" if the government is shut down for the listed number of days, inclusive of the beginning and ending dates, during this market's above-specified time frame.

A qualifying government shutdown will be defined as having begun when the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) announces that the U.S. federal government is shut down due to a lapse in appropriations.

The end date of the shutdown will be determined by the date on which the funding bill required to reopen the government is signed by the President or otherwise enacted. The announcement of an impending reopen will not qualify.

Partial shutdowns count as shutdowns; announcements of office closures due to holidays or inclement weather do not qualify as a shutdown.

The resolution source for this market will be OPM's Operating Status page (<https://www.opm.gov/policy-data-oversight/snow-dismissal-procedures/current-status/>), information from official U.S. Government sources, and a consensus of credible reporting.

### 4. Russia x Ukraine ceasefire

This market will resolve to "Something" if there is an official ceasefire agreement, defined as a publicly announced and mutually agreed halt in military engagement, between Russia and Ukraine during this market's above-specified time frame.

If the agreement is officially reached before the resolution date, this market will resolve to "Something," regardless of whether the ceasefire officially starts afterward.

Only ceasefires that constitute a general pause in the conflict will qualify. Ceasefires that only apply to energy infrastructure, the Black Sea, or other similar agreements will not qualify.

Any form of informal agreement will not be considered an official ceasefire. Humanitarian pauses will not count toward the resolution of this market.

A peace deal or political framework will qualify if it includes a publicly announced and mutually agreed halt in military engagement, effective on a specific date. Frameworks or agreements that outline terms for a future peace but do not include an explicit, dated commitment to stop fighting will not count.

This market's resolution will be based on official announcements from both Russia and Ukraine; however, a wide consensus of credible media reporting stating an official ceasefire agreement between Russia and Ukraine has been reached will suffice.

### 5. André Ventura wins Portugal Presidential Election

This market will resolve "Something" if the listed candidate wins the listed election during this market's above-specified time frame.

This market includes any potential second round. If the result of this election isn't known during this market's above-specified time frame, this will not qualify.

This market will resolve based on the result of the election as indicated by a consensus of credible reporting. If there is ambiguity, this market will resolve based solely on the official results as reported by

the Portuguese government, specifically the National Election Commission (Comissão Nacional de Eleições, CNE) (<https://www.cne.pt/>).

#### 6. LDP does not win most seats in Japan General Election

General elections are scheduled to be held in Japan on February 8, 2026.

This market will resolve to "Something" if the listed Party does not win the greatest number of seats in the next Japanese House of Representatives (衆議院, Shūgiin) election.

If the results are not known definitively during this market's above-specified time frame, this will not qualify.

A tie between the listed party and at least one other party for the most seats won will not qualify for a "Something" resolution.

This market's resolution will be based solely on the number of seats won by the named party in the House of Representatives of the Japanese National Diet.

This market will resolve based on the results of the election, as indicated by a consensus of credible reporting. If there is ambiguity, this market will resolve based solely on the official results reported by the Japanese government, including the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications (<https://www.soumu.go.jp/>) or e-Stat (Japan's government statistics portal; <https://www.e-stat.go.jp/>).

Note: If a listed party contests the election as part of a jointly listed coalition with one or more parties not listed in this market (including through merger), the market corresponding to the listed party will represent the coalition and will count all seats won by the coalition collectively. If two or more listed parties contest the election as a jointly listed coalition (including through merger), with or without additional parties not listed in this market, the market corresponding to the party within that coalition that won the most seats in the previous election will represent the coalition and will count all seats won by the coalition collectively. If such a coalition dissolves, each market will again represent its respective party individually.

#### 7. Gold (GC) hits ↑ \$8,000

This market will resolve to "Something" if, on any trading day, the official CME settlement price for the Active Month (front month) of Gold (GC) futures is equal to or above the listed price by the final trading day of this market's above-specified time frame.

For CME Gold (GC) futures contracts, the Active Month is the nearest of CME's designated delivery-cycle months (February, April, June, August, October, December) that is not the spot month. The Active Month changes automatically on the contract's First Position Date, at which point the next eligible contract month becomes the Active Month.

Only the Active Month's official settlement price published by CME Group will be considered. Intraday trades, highs, lows, bids, offers, midpoint values, or indicative prices do not count.

Note that the settlement price may differ from the last traded price. CME's methodology to determine the settlement price can vary by commodity and contract.

Only days on which CME publishes an official settlement price for the Active Month will be included. Days without settlement prices (weekends, holidays, or market closures) are ignored.

This market will resolve based on the settlement price as it appears on the CME settlement page at the time it is first published for that trading day, regardless of any later corrections or updates.

The resolution source for this market is the CME Group website — specifically, the daily "Settlement" price for the Active Month of Gold (GC) futures.

#### 8. Bitcoin hits ↓ 60,000

This market will immediately resolve to "Something" if any Binance 1-minute candle for Bitcoin (BTC/USDT) during this market's above-specified time frame has a final "Low" price equal to or lower than the price specified in the title.

The resolution source for this market is Binance, specifically the BTC/USDT "Low" prices available at [https://www.binance.com/en/trade/BTC\\_USDT](https://www.binance.com/en/trade/BTC_USDT), with the chart settings on "1m" for one-minute candles selected on the top bar.

Please note that the outcome of this market depends solely on the price data from the Binance BTC/USDT trading pair. Prices from other exchanges, different trading pairs, or spot markets will not be considered for the resolution of this market.

#### 9. Khamenei out as Supreme Leader of Iran

This market will resolve to "Something" if Iran's Supreme Leader, Ali Khamenei, is removed from power for any length of time during this market's above-specified time frame.

Khamenei will be considered to be removed from power if he resigns, is detained, or otherwise loses his position or is prevented from fulfilling his duties as Supreme Leader of Iran within this market's timeframe.

The primary resolution source for this market will be a consensus of credible reporting.

#### 10. Insurrection Act invoked

This market will resolve to "Something" if Donald Trump officially invokes the Insurrection Act of 1807 during this market's above-specified time frame.

For the purposes of this market, "invoke" means that the President formally announces the use of the Insurrection Act as legal authority for deploying active-duty U.S. military forces or federalizing the National Guard in response to civil disorder, insurrection, or rebellion.

The resolution source will be a consensus of credible reporting.
