

This market will resolve to “No” if any of the following conditions are met by December 31, 2025, 11:59 PM ET:

- US confirms that aliens exist
- Conclusive proof becomes public that the Earth is flat
- Trump says the Moon Landing was faked

Otherwise, this market will resolve to “Yes”.

1. US confirms that aliens exist

This market will resolve to "No" if the President of the United States, any member of the Cabinet of the United States, any member of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, or any US federal agency definitively states that extraterrestrial life or technology exists during this market's above-specified time frame.

The primary resolution source for this market will be official information from the government of the United States; however, a consensus of credible reporting will also be used.

2. Conclusive proof becomes public that the Earth is flat

This market will resolve to "No" if conclusive proof that the earth is flat becomes public during this market's above-specified time frame.

The resolution source for this market will be a consensus of credible reporting.

3. Trump says the Moon Landing was faked

This market will resolve to “No” if Donald Trump publicly claims that any of the moon landings were faked during this market's above-specified time frame.

The claim must come directly from Trump via a verified social media account, official public statement, or during a recorded interview, speech, or rally. Indirect remarks, jokes, or quotes taken out of context will not count.

The primary resolution source for this market will be statements made by Donald Trump; however, a consensus of credible reporting will be used to confirm the legitimacy of such statements.
