

This market will resolve to "Yes" if all of the following conditions are met by December 31, 2025, 11:59 PM ET:

- Trump says Fuck, Fucking or Fucked
- House passes Epstein disclosure bill/resolution
- Trump declares another national emergency

Otherwise, this market will resolve to "No".

This market will remain open until it is confirmed that at least one of the above conditions has not been met, or until all of the above conditions have been met.

1. Trump says Fuck, Fucking or Fucked

This market will resolve to "No" if Donald Trump does not mention Fuck, Fucking or Fucked during this market's above-specified time frame.

Pluralization/possessive of the word will count toward the resolution of this market.

Instances where the term is used in a compound word will count regardless of context (e.g. joyful is not a compound word for "joy," however "killjoy" is a compounding of the words "kill" and "joy").

A 'mention' will include any verbal mention which is recorded (audio or video) and publicly accessible.

Written usages of terms (e.g. Truth Social posts, written statements, etc.) will not count toward this market's resolution.

Videos posted on his social media which were filmed outside this market's time frame will not qualify towards this market's resolution.

2. House passes Epstein disclosure bill/resolution

This market will resolve to "No" if the U.S. House of Representatives does not pass any bill or resolution that explicitly mandates, compels, or formally calls for the public release of documents related to Jeffrey Epstein during this market's above-specified time frame.

The resolution source will be official House voting records and a consensus of credible reporting.

3. Trump declares another national emergency

This market will resolve to "No" if Donald Trump does not formally declare a national emergency under the National Emergencies Act (NEA) during this market's above-specified time frame.

A national emergency must actually be declared for this market to resolve to "Yes" - it will not be enough for Trump to announce an intention to declare a national emergency.

This market's resolution source will be official information from the Trump administration.
