This market will remain open until it is confirmed that at least one of the above conditions has not been met, or until all of the above conditions have been met within the specified timeframe.

1. Trump wins FIFA Peace Prize

The inaugural FIFA Peace Prize is scheduled to be awarded on December 5, 2025, during the final draw for the 2026 FIFA World Cup in Washington, D.C.

This market will resolve to "No" if Donald Trump does not win the 2025 FIFA Peace Prize – Football Unites the World during this market's above-specified time frame.

If Donald Trump wins the prize along with another person or entity, this will count.

The resolution source for this market will be a consensus of credible reporting.

2. Donald Trump is ranked at least #5 in Google's official Year in Search 'People' list for 2025

This market will resolve to "No" if Donald Trump is not ranked in the Top 5 of Google's official Year in Search "People" list for 2025, published on Google's Year in Search hub during this market's above-specified time frame.

The authoritative location is <u>trends.withgoogle.com/year-in-search/</u> (navigate: Global → Trending → People), where the 2025 page will appear once released (as the 2024 page currently shows the Global "People" ranking).

This market may resolve as soon as the official 2025 data is released for the specified timeframe. If none of the listed options ranks within the Top 5 of the respective list, or if Google does not release the 2025 Year in Search by March 31, 2026, 11:59 PM ET, this market will resolve to "Other."

3. 42%+ approval rating for Donald Trump

This market will resolve to "No" if Silver Bulletin's approval rating for Donald Trump for December 31, 2025 is below 42%.

Note that the approval ratings for this date must be finalized before it is considered for this market (namely once the next data point is available, the previous one is finalized).

This market's resolution source will be Silver Bulletin's approval rating poll aggregator, https://www.natesilver.net/p/trump-approval-ratings-nate-silver-bulletin, specifically the approval rating indicated by the green trend line for the resolution date. Changes in the methodology by which Silver Bulletin calculates the approval rating will have no bearing on the resolution of this market. If Silver Bulletin's approval rating becomes permanently unavailable, RealClearPolitics will be used.

The resolution source reports the rating value to only one decimal point (e.g. 42.8%, 33.9%, etc). Thus, this is the level of precision that will be used when resolving the market
